



Preschool session times:

Our Preschool operates flexible hours, offering places for 24 children in the morning and 24 children in the afternoon. Children come to the Preschool for either a whole day including lunch club or for half a day (lunch club optional). We take children from the age of 3 years old. They start in the term after their 3rd birthday.

Morning session: 8:50am – 11:50am (no lunch session)

Afternoon session: 11.50am – 3:00pm (to include lunch session)

Our learning environments:

Our aim is to provide children with an exciting and inspiring learning environment to engage in "exploration" that is designed to challenge, cultivate character, and ensure our youngest children have high quality resources and provision to develop their knowledge and skills in all seven areas of Early Years Learning.




Early Years Curriculum Aims:

Our ACE EYFS Curriculum empowers and inspires children to be curious, empathetic, determined and unique individuals through cultivating their character.

Our children will be immersed in the experience of being a historian, scientist or writer, perhaps developing a passion that will inform their future lives.

Reading


Reading and language development at home is really important to ensure good progress for your child. We encourage your child to bring a book bag into school and once a week they will receive a library book to take home for you to share and enjoy together. As your child progresses through Preschool they will become more confident with initial sound recognition.

Tapestry -Online Learning Journal



Tapestry builds a special record of a child's experiences, development and learning journey through the early years education.

Tapestry is an app that enables learning experiences and memories to be shared with the child's family and weaves the story of how the child is growing and developing.

You are able to comment on your child's progress, but also have the opportunity to upload comments and media of experiences that you are having within the home learning environment.

This communication between staff and parents builds up a shared understanding of how every child can reach their full potential.

Each week we use Tapestry to send home learning with different activities and links to books so that you can support your child further within the current learning experience.

Lunchtime

As you may be aware, all children in Preschool will have their lunch with us (depending on session times). Please talk to your child about the food choices and check they are happy with what you have selected. Alternatively, please provide your child with a packed lunch for their session.

You will need to select your child's meal choice online through our school App MCAS.

The options for Preschool hot meal will be displayed on the menu (by the front door) and shared with you on Tapestry.



What does your child need to bring?

All items must be named.

• Tiny Torre Preschool school uniform (optional but preferred for Preschool children)

White polo shirt, school jumper/cardigan(with school logo or plain navy blue) grey/black trousers/joggers/leggings/shorts, skirt, pinafore, black school shoes with velcro (NO laces please) and grey socks or tights.

- A water bottle
- Two changes of clothes including pants/socks (these don't need to be uniform)
- Welly Boots
- Nappies/pull ups, wet wipes and nappy bags (if appropriate and still required)
